REGISTRATION AND VOTING INFORMATION

TO BE ELIGIBLE TO VOTE you must be a citizen of the United States; at least 18 years of age by Election Day; a resident of Westchester County for 30 days prior to the election, and registered. If you have moved since the last time you voted, you must re-register. (See "Registration")

GENERAL ELECTIONS are held on the first Tuesday following the first Monday in November. If you are registered with the Westchester County Board of Elections, you are automatically eligible to vote in all general, village and school elections.

In order to vote in a **Primary Election**, you must be registered with the party holding the election. Primary dates are set by the State Legislature.

Absentee ballots may be obtained in person or by telephone from the Westchester County Board of Elections. An absentee ballot must be postmarked by the day preceding the election and received up to 7 days after by the Board of Elections in order to be counted.

The **handicapped physically challenged** may vote even if unable to sign. Call the Board of Elections for instructions.

LOCAL ELECTIONS

Village elections are held on the third Tuesday in March. This year the date is March 18, 2008. If you are not registered to vote in the general election, you are not eligible to vote in the Village elections. Absentee ballots may be obtained at Village Hall.

School Board elections are held on the third Tuesday in May. This year the date is May 20, 2008. If you are not registered to vote in the general election, you may vote in the School Board elections by registering at the Scarsdale Board of Education office located at Scarsdale High School, Brewster Road. Absentee ballots may be obtained at the Board office.

You may also **register by mail**. Mail applications are always available at Scarsdale Village Hall, the Scarsdale Public Library and the Scarsdale Post Office. All applications must be received by the Westchester County Board of Elections at least 25 days prior to the election.

You must vote once every five years to maintain your registration.

If you **move within Westchester County**, you may transfer your registration by sending a letter with your new address, and bearing your signature, to the Westchester County Board of Elections.

If you **change your name**, you may notify the Board of Elections by sending a letter bearing your new signature to the Westchester County Board of Elections.
